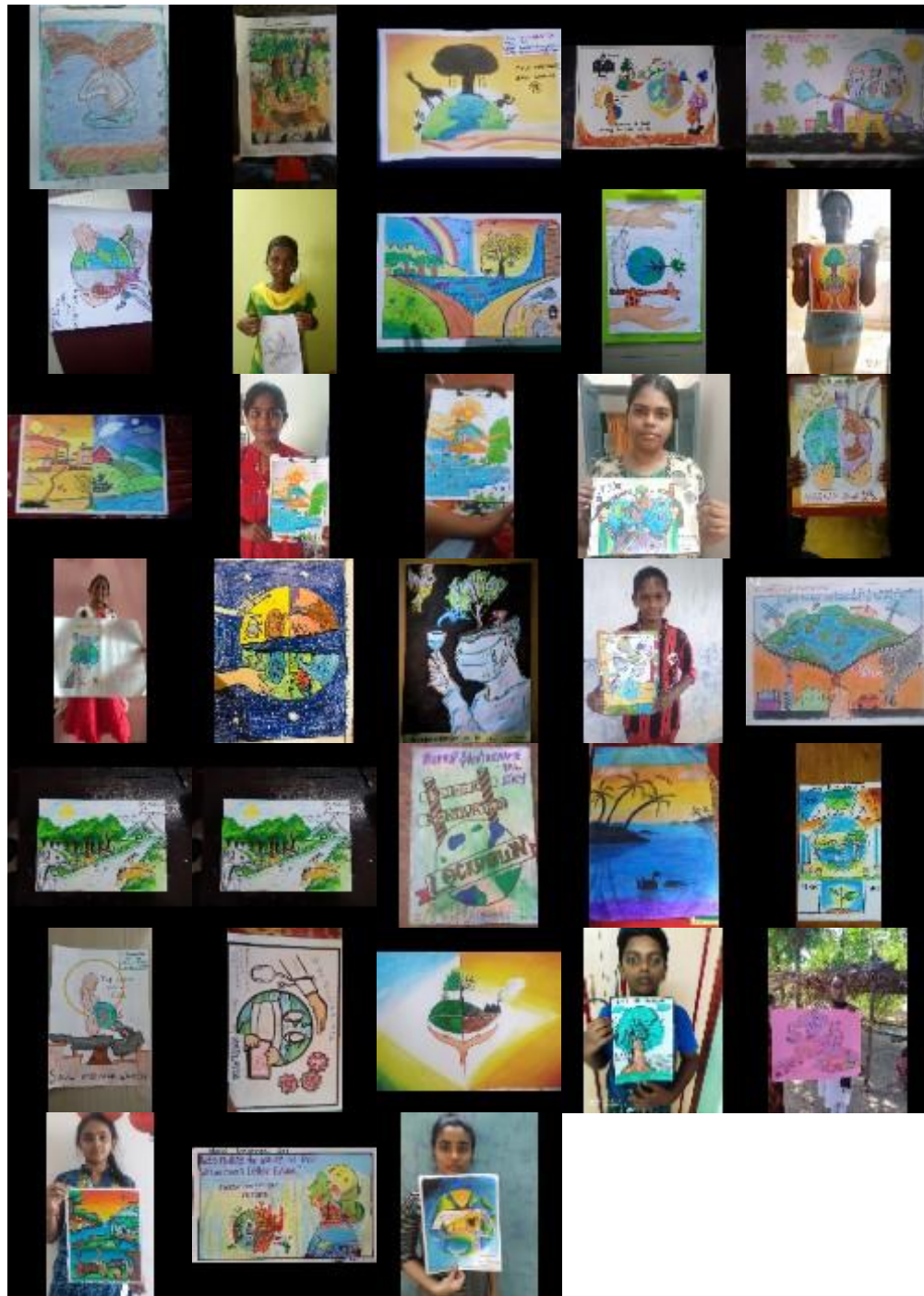












Children participated with all their energies, some have taken from the internet and drawn it and some have mixed it with their creativity and drawn it and some are really indigenous created drawings from their own

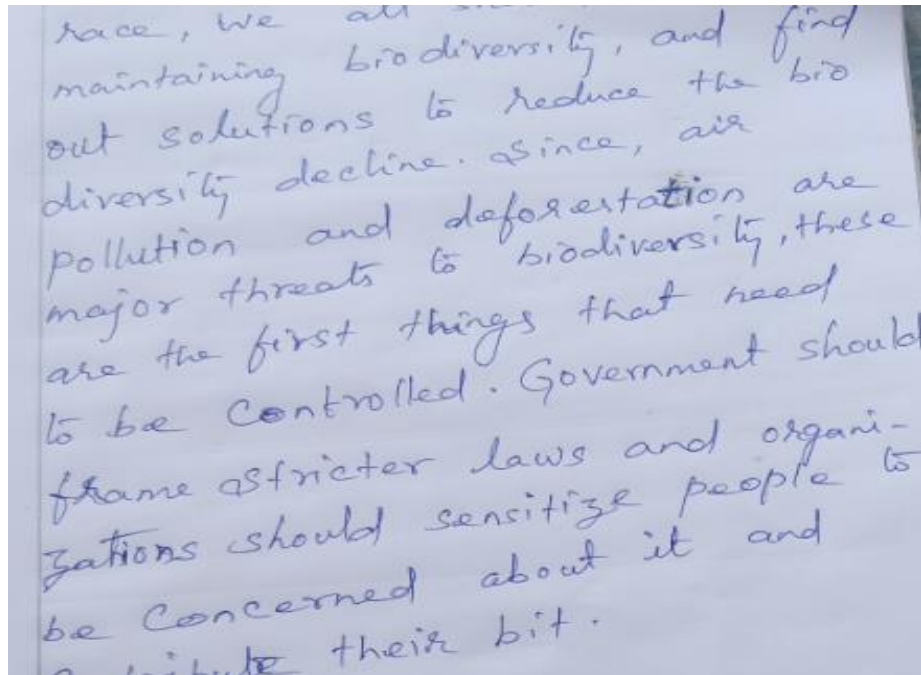
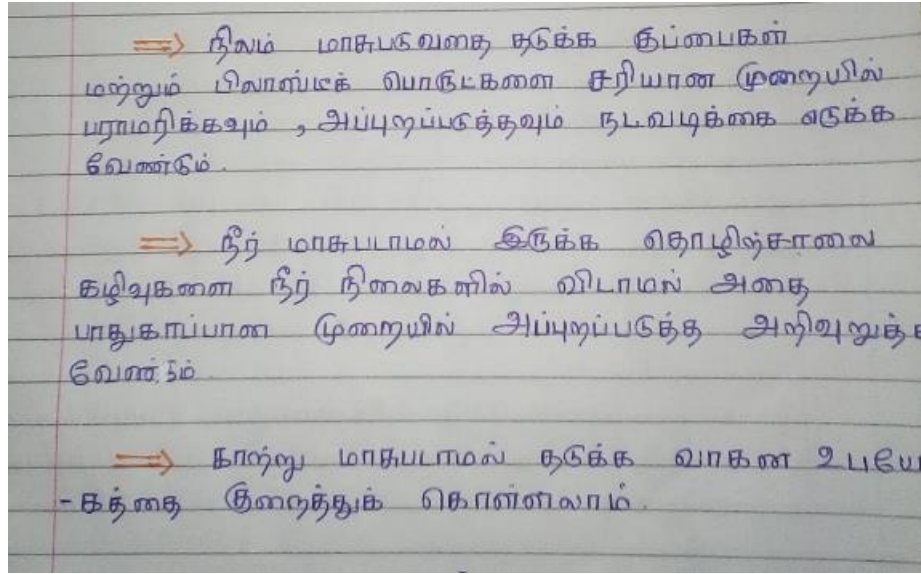


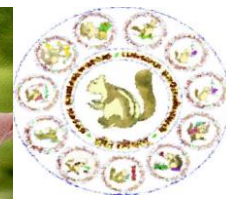

On June 5, 2020 Hand in Hand India, Rameswaram Municipality and Green Rameswaram together conducted a World Environment Day event on June 5, 2020.

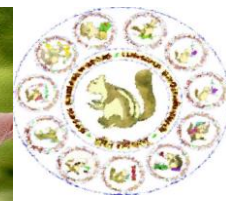
### **Tamil Thai Vaazhthu - by Hand in Hand India team**

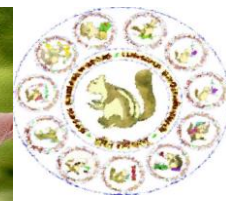
Then the District Collector served food to the Green Friends and the function concluded.

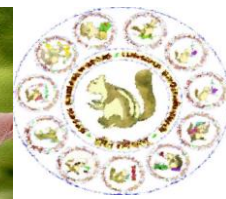
