Vivekananda Kendra - NARDEP conducted a series of awareness programs in Rameswaram Island to introduce alternative livelihood options to the local community, particularly focusing on fisherwomen and men. The aim was to diversify income sources and promote sustainable practices. The programme is supported by L & T Technology Service, Bangalore The project team assessed the livestock options available to the community.

The number of cows, goats and poultry owned by participants was documented, indicating existing livestock practices. The project noted a growing interest among households in establishing kitchen gardens. It was decided to give training to the selected 100 stakeholders after carrying out the survey for better livelihood. The options suggested are (i) Kitchen garden (ii) Backyard poultry and (iii) Goatery.
