- Formed 26 new groups (thus the total number of groups $46 + 26 = 72$)

On 27 July 2021 we carried out the Social Mapping exercise at Ramakrishnapuram with the help of local stakeholders. Initially, there were less people because of the function at Rameswaram. However, subsequently, most of the people joined in this novel exercise. We collected the following information.

- Around 98 households are partially educated and have not crossed even 10th std
- 63 households are not having toilets
- 4 households are not having wells
- Fishing and allied activities are majority in the place
