



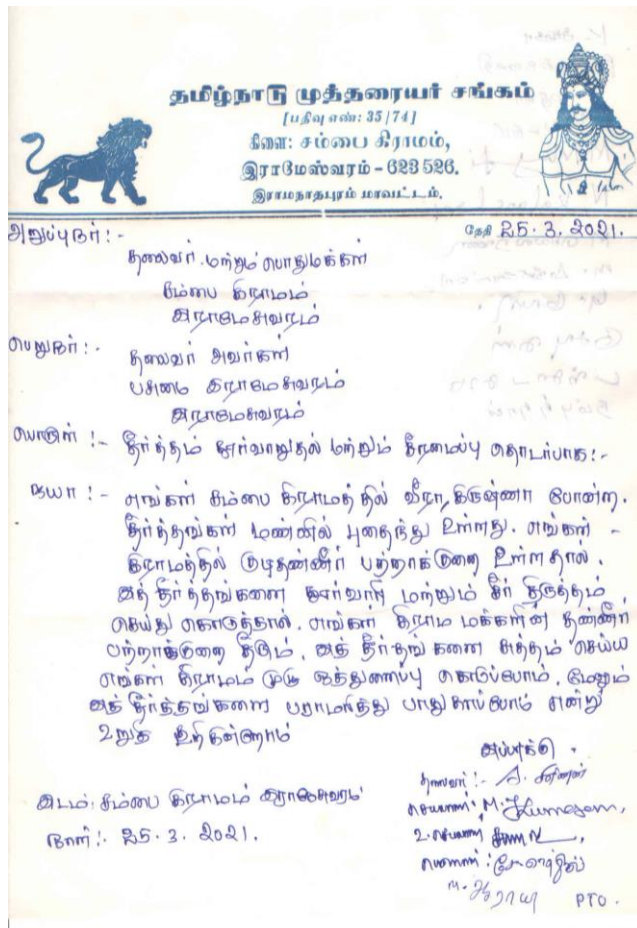
“Revival and Renovation of Traditional Water Bodies”
