Source Segregation Demonstration programmes:

15 Source Segregation Demonstration programmes have been organized during the month of December on 1th, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 7th, 8th, 15th in Ward No.1 - Ondiveeran Nagar Ward No. 2 – Kattu Pillar Kovil Street, Ward No.3-Kachankulam and Ward No.7-Mandistreet



Through these programmes, our project team and green friends gave awareness to the households in each ward about the types of waste, segregation of waste and the importance and benefits of recycling. A live demonstration on Source Segregation was also organized for the public in which the importance and the need for source segregation were insisted. People were explained about the process of global warming and land pollution which is caused by the mixed waste which is dumped in the dumping yard.

Door to Door Awareness Programme

Forty, Door-to-Door Awareness programmes has been conducted in the Municipality on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 7th, 10th, 12th, 14th, 15th, 16th, 18th, 19th, 20th of December in Ward No.1 – Erakadu, Ward No.3 - Salli Malai, Ward No 8 - Murugavadi, Ward No.10- Gandhi Nagar, Ward No.11 – Ponnan Nagar, Ward No.5 - North Street, Ward No.14 - Channathi Street, Ward No.16 - Verkadu, Ward No.18 - Rajagopal Nagar, Ward No.19 - Puthu Road, Ward No.20 - Rameswaram Road respectively. 1700 households were sensitized on the issues of Waste management in Rameswaram and were sensitized about the importance of MSWM and segregation of waste at source in the households itself.



They were explained that this is the only solution for keeping the environment clean for a better future of the children.
