

A Rare book - Dhevaiula on Ramanathaswami



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This classical work on Sri Ramanatha Swami of Rameswaram was composed by "Palapattadai Chokkanatha Pillai". This work was discovered by Sri U.Ve.Saminatha Iyer after comparing multiple versions. He also wrote a commentary on this rare text. He is affectionately called Tamil Thatha (literally, "Tamil grandfather")

Different types of female devotees, who were in a state of trance had assembled to have the darshan of our Lord Ramanathaswamy. Some of them are:

- 1. Devotees whose ornaments were switched between their hands and legs
- 2. Devotees who were dazed as if they were to swim & cross the sea
- 3. Devotees who were crushed in the crowd and approaching from 4 directions
- 4. Devotees who lost weight because of their continuous mental suffering (being separated from the Lord)
- 5. Devotees who sweated profusely
- 6. Devotees who could not identify their bodily parts, correctly
- 7. Devotees who checked the dresses of other devotees
- 8. Devotees who could not get the grace of the Lord
