1. Anandalaya

We launched the Anandalaya initiative in August with the aim of enhancing the academic and personal growth of rural and underprivileged children. The programme adopts a holistic approach to learning that nurtures four key dimensions of child development — Shiksha (Education), Samskara (Values), Swasthya (Health), and Swabhimana (Self-Esteem).

In October, 16 Anandalaya Centres were operational, benefiting a total of 276 students. During this period, visits were made to all the centres to monitor progress and to encourage the ongoing activities.
