### 3. Anandalaya

We have launched the Anandalaya initiative with the objective of enhancing the academic and personal growth of rural and underprivileged children. The programme adopts a holistic approach to learning that nurtures four key dimensions of child development — Shiksha (Education), Samskara (Values), Swasthya (Health), and Swabhiman (Self-Esteem).

In November, 20 Anandalaya Centres were operational, benefiting a total of 334 students. During this period, visits were made to all the centers to monitor progress and to encourage the ongoing activities.
