### **1. Foundation Day:**

The 12th Foundation Day of Green Rameswaram Trust was celebrated on 2nd February 2026 with great enthusiasm and collective pride, with more than 1,400 participants in attendance. The programme commenced at 1:30 PM with a vibrant cultural presentation by Anandalaya students, featuring dance, Silambam, Thirukkural recitation, and a meaningful drama.

The formal inauguration was marked by the lighting of the ceremonial lamp by Shri Shivaprasad, Managing Director, Avantika by the Ganges, Varanasi; Shri Ananda Kumar Reddy, Member, Thirumala Tirupati Devasthanam Board, Tamil Nadu; and Shri Sheik Saleem, and Shri.G.Vasudeo, Trustees, Green Rameswaram Trust.
