2. Visit of the representative of ANI (Asian News International) News Channel:

On 21st March 2026, the ANI News Channel team visited Green Rameswaram Trust to document its key social, environmental, and community development initiatives. The team first covered Simha Teertham at Pamban, where Self-Help Group (SHG) members demonstrated the monthly Teertha Pooja, showcasing traditional practices and community participation. They then visited Erakadu Village to document livelihood support activities, capturing how beneficiaries have improved their income and living standards through the Trust's interventions.

Further documentation included a household Bio-Gas unit, reflecting the promotion of eco-friendly energy solutions. Alongside this, the team recorded a cleaning programme at Agni Teertham, where children and college students actively participated, emphasizing environmental awareness and civic responsibility. The visit concluded at the RO Water Plant in Ramakrishnapuram, where the team documented access to safe drinking water and its benefits to the local community.
